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## **Board Highlights**

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March 23, 2018

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### **Board Business:**

1. The Board resolved to send correspondence to the Honourable Nathan Cullen, MP, in support of bringing the federal government to the table to discuss safe, viable transportation options in light of the Passenger Transportation Board's decision to allow Greyhound service to the northwest region to cease commencing June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
2. The Board received correspondence from Northern Development Initiative Trust indicating that the North Coast Regional District was successful in its application to the 2018 Economic Development Capacity Building and Grant Writing Support programs.
3. The Board directed staff to prepare amendment bylaws to the Graham Island Official Community Plan and Zoning bylaws for consideration at the April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Regular Board meeting to be held in Port Clements, B.C.
4. Recognizing a partnership opportunity, the Board resolved to, through a service provider agreement, extend liability coverage provided by the Municipal Insurance Association of B.C. to the Haida Gwaii Youth Soccer League.
5. The Board resolved to submit a resolution concerning Highway 16 safety at the Carwash Rock and Kasik sections to the TransCanada Yellowhead Highway Association for consideration at its Annual General Meeting to be held April 8, 2018.
6. Following a three month budgeting process which, for the first time, included online public engagement, the Board adopted the North Coast Regional District 2018-2022 Five Year Financial Plan Bylaw 622, 2018.
