

#### Bylaw No. 685, 2023

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 276, 1995 "Island Solid Waste Management Regulation, Fees, and Charges" as amended, that fixes and regulates the rates, terms and conditions which waste management services may be supplied on Haida Gwaii.

**WHEREAS** the Board of the North Coast Regional District wishes to amend the Island Solid Waste Regulation, Fees, and Charges Bylaw No. 276, 1995, as amended, in order to fix and regulate the rates terms and conditions which waste management services may be supplied on Haida Gwaii;

**NOW THEREFORE** the North Coast Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

#### 1. CITATION

a) This bylaw may be cited as "Islands Solid Waste Management Regulation, Fees & Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 685, 2023."

### 2. Amending

a) Schedule A, Fees & Charges of the North Coast Regional District Solid Waste Management Regulation, Fees & Charges Bylaw No. 276, 1995, and subsequent amendments thereto, is hereby amended and replaced with the attached Schedule A, Fees & Charges, which forms part of this bylaw.
