SKEENA-QUEEN CHARLOTTE REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 280

Being a bylaw to establish the North Pacific Cannery Village Museum Grant-in-Aid Local Service

WHEREAS under the provision of Section 788(e), of the Municipal Act the Board is authorized to establish the local service of museums;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District has been requested to establish a local service for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid towards the cost of operating the North Pacific Cannery Village and Museum, by the counter petition process.

AND WHEREAS the Board deems it appropriate to pay this grant-in-aid to the North Pacific Cannery Village and Museum for the purpose aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS the Councils of the City of Prince Rupert and the District of Port Edward have provided consent under Section 799 of the *Municipal Act*.

AND WHEREAS the Regional District Board has obtained the assent required for Electoral Areas "A" and "C" under the provisions of Section 797 of the *Municipal Act*.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THE SERVICE

The local service of North Pacific Cannery Village and Museum grant-in-aid is hereby established for the City of Prince Rupert, District of Port Edward, Electoral Area "A" and Electoral Area "C".

Service Area and Participating Areas

- 2. The service area boundaries for the service shall be coterminous with that of the City of Prince Rupert, District of Port Edward, Electoral Areas "A" and "C" of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District.
- 3. Participating areas shall be the City of Prince Rupert, District of Port Edward, Electoral Areas "A" and "C".

Cost Recovery And apportionment of Cost

- 4. The annual cost of the service shall be levied and collected by a property value tax on the net taxable value of land and improvements for hospital purposes within the service area.
- 5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually under Section 804(1) for the cost of the Local Service shall be \$80,000.

- 6. The apportionment of the net costs of the service shall be on a ratio basis as follows:
 - a) City of Prince Rupert 2/5ths;
 - b) District of Port Edward 2/5ths; and
 - c) Electoral Areas "A" and "C" 1/5 of the cost. The costs between electoral areas A and C shall be apportioned based on its converted value of land and improvements for hospital purposes.
- 7. This Bylaw may be cited as the "North Pacific Village Cannery Museum Local Service Establishment ByLaw No. 280, 1995".
