SKEENA-QUEEN CHARLOTTE REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 459, 2004

Being a bylaw to establish a service within Electoral Areas D, E and F to provide an emergency program.

WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor-in-Council, by B.C. Regulation 126/97, has granted the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District authority to provide an Emergency Program as an extended service under the *Emergency Program Act*;

WHEREAS the Board considers it necessary to establish an Emergency Program to plan, organize, establish and operate salvage, precautionary and safety measures, controls, facilities and services of all kinds vital and necessary for the public welfare for meeting, preventing, reducing and overcoming effects of civil disaster in and for the Electoral Areas D, E and F;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 801.5 of the *Local Government Act*, the Directors of Electoral Areas D, E and F have given consent on behalf of the electors within the electoral participating areas to the adoption of this Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

SERVICE

- 1. Regional District Board hereby establishes a service to provide an emergency program under the *Emergency Program Act* within Electoral Areas D, E and F.
- 2. The boundaries of the service area are the boundaries of Electoral Areas D, E and F.
- 3. The participants in the service established under section 2 of this Bylaw are Electoral Areas D, E and F.
- 4. The maximum amount of money that can be requisitioned annually under section 803 (1)(a) of the Local Government Act for the service provided under section 2 of this Bylaw shall not exceed .50 cents per thousand to be collected by a property value tax on the net taxable value of land and improvements for hospital purposes with the respective electoral areas.
