

## SKEENA-QUEEN CHARLOTTE REGIONAL DISTRICT

### BYLAW NO. 469-2005

---

#### A Bylaw to Establish a Water Service in a Portion of Electoral Area "E" - Sandspit

---

*WHEREAS* pursuant to Sections 796(1) and 800(1) of the *Local Government Act*, a Regional District may, by bylaw, establish and operate any service that the Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the regional district;

*AND WHEREAS* the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District wishes to establish a water service in a portion of Electoral Area "E" - Sandspit;

*AND WHEREAS* pursuant to Section 797.4 of the *Local Government Act* the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District has received a sufficient "*petition for services*";

*AND WHEREAS* the Director of Electoral Area "E" - Sandspit has consented, in writing, to the adoption of this Bylaw;

*NOW THEREFORE*, the Regional Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. **CITATION**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District Sandspit Water Service Establishment Bylaw 469, 2005".

2. **SERVICE BEING ESTABLISHED**

The service being established under the authority of this Bylaw is the service of the provision, distribution and treatment of water.

3. **SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES**

The Boundaries of the service area are a portion of Electoral Area "E" - Sandspit shown outlined in Schedule "A" of this Bylaw. The service area shall be known as the "Sandspit Water System Service Area".

4. **PARTICIPATING AREA**

Electoral Area "E" - Sandspit is the only participating area of this service.

5. **METHOD OF COST RECOVERY**

The annual cost of providing this service shall be recovered by:

- (a) parcel taxes, to be requisitioned and collected by imposing the tax on the appropriate parcels within the participating area, on the basis of the parcel tax roll; and
- (b) the imposition of fees and other charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw.

**6. MAXIMUM REQUISITION**

The maximum amount of money that may be requisitioned annually in support of this service shall not exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2005

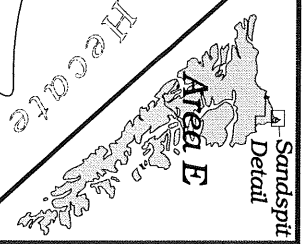
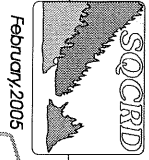
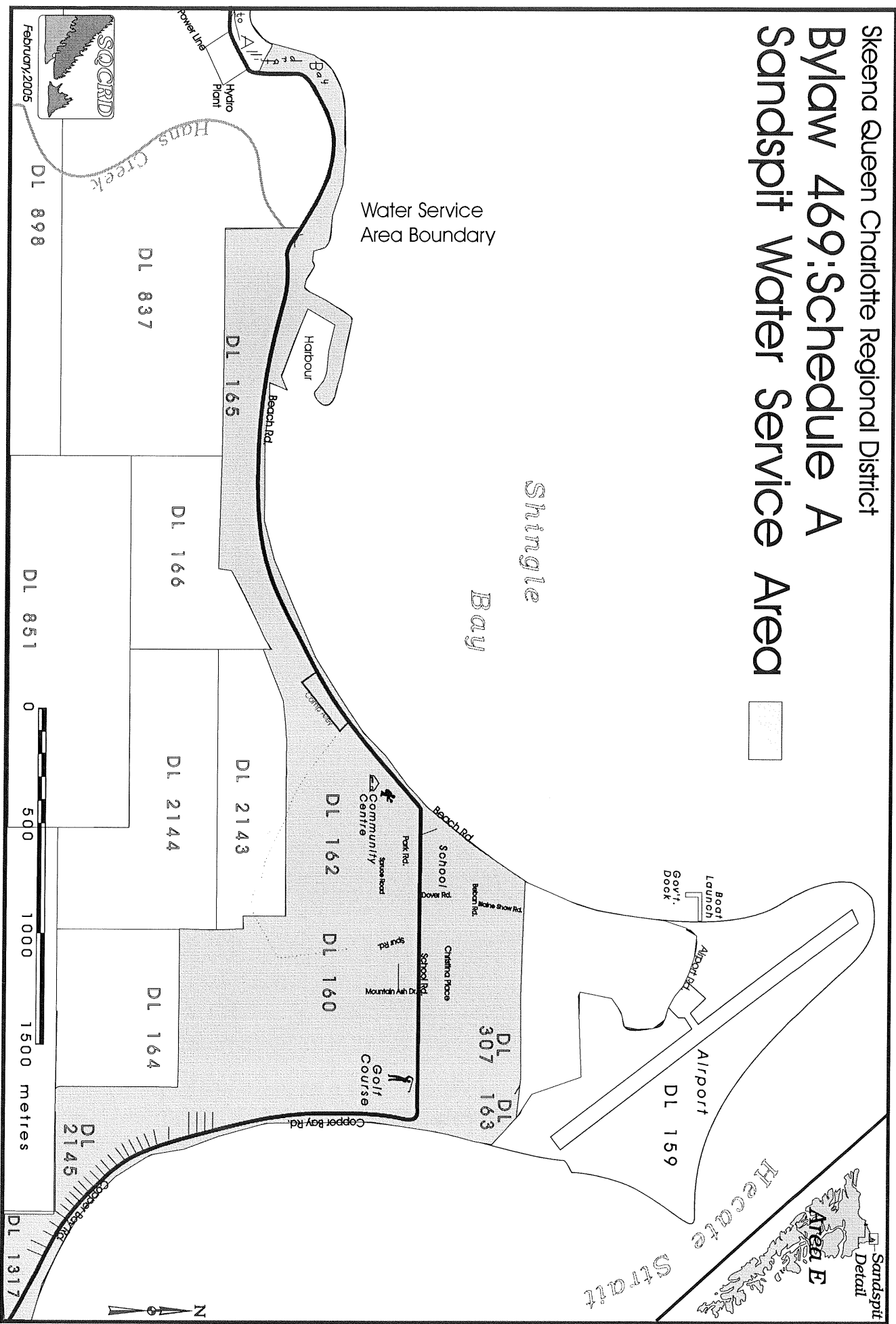
