#### STATEMENT OF SEVERANCE AGREEMENTS

There was 1 severance agreement under which payment commenced between the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District and its non-unionized employees during fiscal year 2007.

## This agreement represents 19 months of compensation.

Compensation means that the Regionasl District will continue the employees salary and benefits with the exceptior of long-term disability insurance coverage. If, prior to the the expiry of the Notice Period, the employee becomes re-employed at ba position paying not less than 50% of her salary with thje Regional District, all subsequent slary continuance payments will cease and the Regional District will provide her with a lump sum equal to 50% of the remaining salary continuance payments.

Benefits included payment of: BC Life premiums, Pacific Blue Cross premiums, MSP premiums, Municipal Pension Plan contriutions.
