



Board Highlights

May 25th, 2018

Board Business:

1. The Board appointed Director Lee Brain to the Highway 16 Electric Vehicle Charging Network Collaboration Study Advisory Committee. The Committee will advise the efforts of the Community Energy Association as it pertains to the establishment of an electric vehicle charging network along Highway 16.
2. The Board received correspondence from Northern Development Initiative Trust with respect to receipt of grant funding under the Marketing Initiatives Program to support the North Coast Regional District's rebranding project.
3. The Board resolved to hold its June 15th, 2018 Regular meeting at the Oona River Community Hall in Oona River at 4:00 p.m., to be followed by a dinner in the community that evening.
4. The Board resolved to support the Murrelet Trading Company's application to the Business Façade Improvement Program in the amount of \$3,058 to support the installation of a mural and other various façade improvements.
5. The Board resolved to hold a Committee of the Whole meeting in at the Oona River Community Hall on Saturday, June 16th, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. to consider this year's upcoming UBCM convention and potential resolutions and meeting requests to be brought forward.
6. The Board passed first reading of Bylaw 621, 2018, being a bylaw to provide annual funding to the Lester Centre of the Arts and the Museum of Northern B.C. to support arts and cultural opportunities in the region.
7. Following a public hearing being held on May 23rd, 2018, the Board adopted bylaws 623, 2018 and 624, 2018, being bylaws to amend the Graham Island OCP and Zoning bylaws, respectively.
8. The Board resolved to sign the Haida Nation's Haida Gwaii Commitment to Clean Energy Declaration, committing signatories to transform Haida Gwaii's electrical systems to clean and renewable energy by 2023.
